Located at 945 Front Street, the 24,000 square-foot building houses DPR's existing full-time employees while leaving room to expand in the future. To qualify for NZEB certification by the International Living Future Institute through its Living Building Challenge program, the building must produce as much energy or more than it consumes.

Nineteen Solatube SolaMaster® Series 750 DS units, provided by worldwide leading tubular daylighting device manufacturer Solatube International, Inc., aid in this endeavor by capturing, transferring and delivering bright daylight into the building interior. The units' sustainable design makes it possible to provide illumination using the power of the sun rather than the power of electricity.

"From an energy perspective, Solatube products have been a critical component of our Net-Zero Energy design," said Mike Humphrey, regional manager, DPR Construction. "From a cultural perspective, they have changed the way we behave in our space. People are constantly challenging why we need to have lights on the second floor at all."

If the new building receives Net-Zero Energy Building certification, it will be the third DPR building to be awarded the designation. It will also be the third to use Solatube Daylighting
